December 18, Blast Sunday School will be performing "A Charlie Brown Christmas."


## Ladies Christmas Tea

About a month ago, my paw -paw, Bill Hale, suffered from two heart attacks. It happened while he was at his camp in Pocahontas County. After the heart attack, he was flown from the tiny hospital in Marlington to Roanoke, Virginia where he was then sent home.

Everyone thanked God for protecting him and keeping him safe and then something terrible happened. After being home for only fifteen minutes, the ambulance arrived to take him back to the hospital. He had just had another heart attack. While in the emergency room, his mitral valve erupted. The doubtful doctors told us to be prepared for the worst; the surgery was very tedious and risky. Our family waited for approximately eight hours in

suspense as desperate prayers filled the room.

As I worried, I was reminded of God's faithfulness. I understood that our prayers had to be answered because of God's amazing mercy. When the surgeon returned, the tone in his voice was far from consoling, but paw-paw had survived the surgery. The next 48 hours were critical. Prayers were being sent up from every direction and God certainly answered.

After two heart attacks, a quadruple bypass, and a replaced mitral valve, my paw-paw is miraculously doing fine. We were told by the nurses that it was an absolute miracle that he survived and it certainly was. God is amazing and words cannot express how truly grateful I am.
