

Eligibility & Obligations

1. Anyone believing in and accepting the Apostolic doctrine as set forth in our Articles of Faith given briefly below is eligible to become a "Ministry Team Member" of the Jonesport Pentecostal Church, including anyone involved as Musicians; Singers; Worship Leaders; Sunday School Ministry Workers, Children's Ministry Workers, Youth Ministry Workers, etc..

(a) We believe God's Word teaches that the Bible standard of full salvation is repentance, baptism in water by immersion in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and the baptism of the Holy Ghost with the initial sign of speaking with other tongues as the Spirit gives the utterance.

_____ *I believe in and have experienced this Bible standard of Salvation, given in Acts 2:38.*

(b) We believe God's Word teaches us that there is one ever-living, eternal God that has revealed Himself as Father, Son and Holy Ghost and His name is Jesus. God is a Spirit and before the incarnation, this one true God manifested Himself in different ways. In the incarnation, He manifests Himself in the Son, who walked among men. As He works in the lives of believers, He manifests Himself as the Holy Spirit.

_____ *I believe in and accept that there is only one God, and His name is Jesus.*

(c) We believe God's Word teaches that Godly living should characterize the life of every Christian, and we should live according to the pattern and example given in the Word of God. We wholeheartedly disapprove of our people indulging in any activities which are not conducive to good Christianity and Godly living, such as: Movie Theaters; Dances; Mixed bathing or swimming; Women cutting their hair; Men growing long hair; Jewelry (except wedding bands, watches, etc.); Men wearing women's apparel (dresses, skirts) or women wearing men's apparel (pants, trousers); Men or women wearing any apparel that immodestly exposes the body (no shorts, sleeveless tops, low-cut tops or blouses, slits in skirts should stop below the knee); Using tobacco in any form; Consuming alcohol or illegal drugs of any kind; Or any other activity that would hinder our witness as a child of God.

_____ *I believe in and commit myself to follow these Biblical Holiness teachings of my Pastor and my church.*

(d) We believe God's Word teaches that tithing is God's financial plan to provide for His work, and has been since the days of Abraham. Tithing came with faith under Abraham; Moses' Law enjoined it and Israel practiced it when she was right with God; Jesus endorsed it (**Matthew 23:23**); and Paul said to lay by in store as God has prospered you. Do not rob God of His portion, tithes AND offerings. (**Malachi 3**) Tithing is the minimum, then offerings are above and beyond that.

_____ *I believe in and commit myself to faithfully following God's plan of giving tithes and offerings to my church.*

(e) We believe God's Word teaches us to be faithful in church attendance. (Hebrews 10:25 "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together"...) Church attendance is vital for spiritual growth and strength as well as Prayer Meetings & Pre-Service Prayer Gatherings.

_____ *I believe in and commit myself to being faithful in attending all church services and Prayer meetings at my church. A customary exception would be for sickness, work or when traveling out of town.*

(f) We believe God's Word teaches us to guard our conversation & attitude. I must speak good of my church and leaders at all times. (Prov 6:16-19 "These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, A false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.")

_____ *I believe in and commit myself to guarding my conversation and my attitude and will always talk good about my church and my church leaders.*
